Dear Andrew,

At the most recent Full Council meeting of Wiston Parish Council last Wednesday, the issue of sewage discharge into the Honeybridge Stream was discussed and it was agreed that I should write, to draw your attention to what appears to be a worsening problem.

Data provided by the Rovers Trust (see https://theriverstrust.org/sewage-map) shows that in 2023, the Ashington Wastewater Treatment works sewer storm overflow spilled 107 times for a total of 1,565.91 hours, discharging untreated sewage into the Honeybridge Stream (a tributary of the River Adur and a trout stream). This is a substantial increase on 2022, when it spilled 64 times for a total of 840.46 hours. In 2021, it spilled 67 times for a total of 775 hours.

The reason given for the spillages is 'a lack of hydraulic capacity' which the Parish Council understands to mean that the treatment works are simply inadequate to cope with the amount of sewage reaching them in times of high flow. It seems that our water treatment infrastructure has simply not kept pace with demand.

You may already beware that CPRE Sussex have launched a campaign to address sewage discharges (see https://www.cpresussex.org.uk/news/sewage-new-infrastructure-is-needed-hefore-developments-are-huilt/) and the Parish Council

would be most grateful for any support you can lend to it.
